

The UK Border Agency does not retain records of grants of citizenship prior to October 1986. Before applying for a duplicate certificate you should ensure that it was originally issued from that date.

If you were registered overseas, you should contact the British High Commission in the country where registration took place.

If you are British through an automatic claim to British citizenship rather than through an application for naturalisation or registration, you should apply for a nationality status letter/certificate using form and guide NS.
